Senate Bill 269 as passed the Senate could, beginning in Fiscal Year 2027, increase the obligations of the Public Education Employees' Health Insurance Board by an estimated \$1.6 million annually and the State Employees' Insurance Board by an estimated \$640,000 due to the minimum reimbursement rate set by this bill for health insurers to pay in-network and out-of-network ground ambulance providers.

Further, this bill would increase the obligations of the Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH) by an undetermined amount to adopt rules and obtain annual reports from emergency medical service providers and health care insurers due to the provisions of this bill.

The requirements would sunset June 1, 2029.
