SYNOPSIS:

Existing law requires owners of manufactured homes to apply with the Alabama Department of Revenue for a manufactured home certificate of title unless the manufactured homes are designated as model years 1999 or earlier.

This bill would authorize the Alabama Department of Revenue to issue certificates of title to current owners of manufactured homes designated as model year 1999 or earlier upon the owner's application.

TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to manufactured homes; to amend Section 32-20-21, Code of Alabama 1975; to authorize Alabama Department of Revenue to issue certificates of title to current owners of manufactured homes model year 1999 and earlier; and to make nonsubstantive, technical revisions to update the existing code language to current style.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:



SB282 INTRODUCED

29 Section 1. Section 32-20-21, Code of Alabama 1975, is
30 amended to read as follows:

31 "§32-20-21

32 No certificate of title shall be issued for any of the
33 following:

34 (1) A manufactured home owned by the United States or
35 any agency thereof.

36 (2) A manufactured home owned by a manufacturer or
37 licensed manufactured home dealer and held for sale.

38 (3) A manufactured home owned by a nonresident of this
39 state and not located in this state.

40 (4) Manufactured homes designated 1999 and prior year
41 models, unless requested by a current owner pursuant to this
42 article.

43 (5) Modular homes.

44 (6) A manufactured home situated in this state and
45 permanently affixed to the real property on which it is placed
46 and for which the certificate of title or the manufacturer's
47 certificate of origin has been ~~cancelled~~ canceled pursuant to
48 ~~subsection (b) of~~ Section 32-20-20 (b).

49 (7) Any other manufactured homes as prescribed by the
50 department."

51 Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,
52 2026.
